

BESS photovoltaic panel price inquiry in the Netherlands

How does a Bess asset optimisation impact variable grid fees?

The operational profile of BESS assets effectively determines the burden of variable grid fees that owners incur. For example there will be periods where revenue is willingly forgone, in order to avoid variable grid fees. In other words the variable grid fee impact needs to be analysed as part of BESS asset optimisation.

How much energy does Bess need?

The government has also indicated that the BESS will need to obtain at least 75% of its energy from the co-located generation. That compares to the effective 100% requirement that solar-plus-storage projects used to need in order to qualify for an investment tax credit (ITC) in the US, and still do for Germany's Innovation Tender.
