Where is Sao Tome and Principe located?

Sao Tome and Principe is located in the Gulf of Guinea, Atlantic Ocean, off the coast of central Africa. It is composed of two islands, Sao Tome and Principe, which are the remnant part of an extinct volcanic mountain range.

Does Sao Tome & Principe use satellite?

Sao Tome and Principe relied on satellite for international Internet connectivity until the arrival of the ACE undersea fibre-optic cable in 2012. STP Cable was established as a public-private partnership to manage the country's holdings in ACE with the goal of open access and cost-based wholesale costs.

How to call Sao Tome and Principe from another country?

The Sao Tome and Principe telephone country code is the number 239. If you want to call Sao Tome and Principe from another country, you can do it dialing the number 239, before the entire telephone number. Each country has its own number to identify this area.

What does Sao Tome and Principe stand for?

The most commonly used abbreviations about Sao Tome and Principe are ST which stands for Sao Tome and Principe and STN which means Dobra (Sao Tome and Principe currency). Does Sao Tome & Principe have a microwave link?

A high-capacity microwave connection was deployed between the islands of Sao Tome and Principe in 2015. The transmission link covers 176 km, one of the longest microwave routes in the world, and provides 300 Mbit/s of capacity, more than nine times the previous link.

What is the 3/2004 base law of telecommunications?
