

Who owns MVNO base in Belgium?

Belgium's third MNO BASE (Telenet) is a subsidiary of Liberty Global and has a 23% market share. It has been an active player in Belgium's mobile market through an MVNO since 2006. In April 2015, Telenet acquired BASE from Dutch KPN, strengthening its position on the market and migrating its mobile customers to Base's network.

Does Telenet offer mobile telephony in Belgium?

Under the brand name Telenet, the company focuses on offering digital television, high-speed Internet and fixed and mobile telephony services to residential customers in Flanders and Brussels. Under the brand name BASE, it supplies mobile telephony in Belgium.

How many satellite stations does Belgium have?

For international communications, Belgium has 5 submarine cables and a number of satellite earth stations, two of which are Intelsat, and one Eutelsat. ^"Belgium".
