What is 5G & how does it work in Guyana?

In September 2020, E-Networks became the first company in Guyana to bring a 5G network to market. This 5G network, which uses the latest generation of wireless connectivity globally, was designed to meet growing internet demands, and deliver faster speeds at lower pricing to the Guyanese people.

How much does 5G internet cost in Guyana?

The locally-owned telecommunications company in Guyana offers \$7,900 GY per month for their 5G and fiber internet service with a minimum speed of 20 Mbps and Dream TV Mobile. The cost and specific bandwidth depend on the selected package.

Does E-Networks work in Guyana?

The network offers both home and business internet services to Guyanese across the most densely populated parts of Guyana. E-Networks, in a partnership with a local consortium, landed an international subsea cable that links Barbados to Guyana.

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How did E-Networks become the first cable TV company in Guyana?

This system made E-Networks the pioneer of cable TV in Guyana, with the introduction of DreamTV Wireless, and allowed E-Networks to become the only company in the Caribbean at the time with a true triple-play (voice, data, video) wireless solution.
