How many Watts Does a solar panel produce?

How much wattage does a solar PV system have?

The wattage of the solar panels, in this case, is crucial in determining the overall capacity of the system. Your system may consist of 20 x 330W panels, resulting in a 6,600W (6.6kW) solar PV system. A solar photovoltaic (PV) system's size or capacity is the maximum amount of electricity it can produce.

Wattage refers to the amount of electrical power a solar panel can produce under standard test conditions (STC), which simulate a bright sunny day with optimal solar irradiance (1,000 W/m²), a cell temperature of 25°C, and clean panels.
