How many mobile phone companies are there in Papua New Guinea (PNG)?

There are three Mobile Phone Companies or operators in Papua New Guinea (PNG). These companies are Digicel, Bmobile-Vodafone and Telikom PNG. Below is the description of each of the companies. 1. Digicel Digicel is a mobile phone network provider operating in 31 markets across the Caribbean, Central America, and Oceania regions.

How many base stations does Vodafone PNG have?

Vodafone PNG currently has just over 500 base stations. In the next 8 months, they intend to have 800 sites live, progressively expanding coverage to 22 provinces. Currently, they cover approximately 50% of the population with these stations.

How many radio stations are there in Papua New Guinea?

NBC, has for many years, operated an extensive radio network across Papua New Guinea using FM, AM and shortwave transmissions. EM TV has 33 transmitters, NBC, 22 and there are three MMDS operators (one in each market - Port Moresby, Alotau and Mt Hagen).
