How much energy does Greece use?

This makes Greece a country highly dependent on energy imports. According to the Statistical Review of World Energy, primary energy consumption in Greece amounted to 1.05 exajoules and was dominated by oil - 49.5%, followed by natural gas - 23.8%, renewables - 12.2%, coal - 6.7%, and hydroelectricity - 4.8% . How much electricity does Greece produce in 2022?

What infrastructure upgrades are coming to Greece?

Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Infrastructure upgrades include the Revithoussa LNG Terminal, which facilitates 30-40% of Greece's total gas needs. The Alexandroupoli FSRU, operated by Gastrade, started commercial operations in October 2024 and increases Greece's import capacity considerably.
