A panel will usually produce between 250 and 400 watts of power. For the equation later on, assume an average of 320 W per panel. What is solar wattage?

Wattage refers to the amount of electrical power a solar panel can produce under standard test conditions (STC), which simulate a bright sunny day with optimal solar irradiance ($1,000 \text{ W/m}^2$), a cell temperature of 25°C , and clean panels. In simpler terms, a panel's wattage rating tells you its maximum power output under ideal conditions.

How many watts can a 400 watt solar panel produce?

A 100-watt panel can produce 100 watts per hour in direct sunlight. A 400-watt panel can generate 400 watts per hour under the same conditions.
