How much power can a solar panel produce?

What is solar wattage?

Wattage refers to the amount of electrical power a solar panel can produce under standard test conditions (STC), which simulate a bright sunny day with optimal solar irradiance ($1,000 \text{ W/m}^2$), a cell temperature of 25°C , and clean panels. In simpler terms, a panel's wattage rating tells you its maximum power output under ideal conditions.

How many watts can a 400 watt solar panel produce?

A 100-watt panel can produce 100 watts per hour in direct sunlight. A 400-watt panel can generate 400 watts per hour under the same conditions. How many watts can a solar cell make?

Under standard conditions, a cell can make about 0.7 watts. Conditions are $1,000 \text{ W/m}^2$; sunlight, 25°C , and air mass 1.5. How can the power output of a single solar cell be calculated? To find a cell's power, you multiply sunlight by cell efficiency. The formula is: $\text{Power Output} = \text{Solar Irradiance} \times \text{Solar Cell Efficiency}$.
