How much does electricity cost in Uganda?

Uganda's power tariffs are set on a quarterly basis, and the average tariff to consumers is \$0.19/kWh (\$0.09/kWh for large industrial users), with the first 15 units of power subsidized. Umeme Co. Ltd. is the largest energy distributor in Uganda, distributing 93% of all electricity in the country.

What is the electricity demand in Uganda?

The demand for Electricity Consumption in Uganda remains low and among the lowest in Africa with Annual Average Electricity Consumption of 100kWh per capita.

How is electricity supply regulated in Uganda?

Legally, Uganda's Electricity Supply Industry is Regulated under the Electricity Act, 1999, Chapter 45 of the Laws of Uganda, the Energy Policy, the National Environment Act, Chapter 153, and the Statutory Instruments and Guidelines issued by the Electricity Regulatory Authority (ERA).

What percentage of Ugandans have electricity?

In urban areas, 57.2% of Ugandans have access to electricity; however, access drops to 10% in rural areas, and it is only 22.1% nationwide. As of December 2022, Uganda had approximately 3,385 km of transmission lines, which the government aims to increase to 4,354 km by 2025.

What is Uganda's Electricity generation capacity?

Uganda's Electricity Generation Capacity has grown over the years from about 872.2 MW in 2012 to the current 1,254.2 MW (with 5.9 MW on Off-Grid) by December 2019.

What energy sources are used in Uganda?

Uganda enjoyed a Mix of Energy sources including Hydro, Cogeneration/Bagasse, Solar, and Heavy Fuel Oil (HFO). Despite its environmental and cost implications, the existing HFO Plants were installed to provide standby generation in case of shortage of supply from other technologies due to key factors such as drought.
