Who produces electricity in Iceland?

The majority of the electricity is sold to industrial users, mainly aluminium smelters and producers of ferroalloy. The aluminum industry in Iceland used up to 70% of produced electricity in 2013. Landsvirkjun is the country's largest electricity producer.

Where can I buy a power adapter in Iceland?

Power adapters and converters are readily available for purchase in various stores across Iceland, including electronics stores and even some hardware stores. The most convenient option, however, is to pick one up at the duty-free in Keflavik Airport upon arrival but keep in mind that they may not have every possible adapter type available.

Which is the largest geothermal power plant in Iceland?

Hellisheidavirkjun is the largest geothermal power plant in Iceland. Electricity in Iceland is predominantly sourced from renewable resources such as hydroelectric and geothermal power.

Does Iceland need a voltage adapter?

For travelers from countries using 110-120 volts, such as the United States, Canada, and some parts of Central and South America, a voltage adapter is necessary to convert the higher Icelandic voltage to one compatible with their devices.

What voltage is used in Iceland?

This voltage is compatible with most European appliances and electronics. However, travelers visiting from countries with different voltage standards will require a voltage adapter to safely use their devices.
