



The largest energy storage facility in Eastern Europe

What is the largest energy storage facility in Eastern Europe?

The project, the largest in Eastern Europe, has been realised by Solarpro, a company specialising in energy generation and storage solutions across Europe. The facility became operational in early June 2024, following the installation of Hithium's 16 energy storage containers, each with a 3.44MWh capacity.

What is Europe's biggest battery energy storage system?

The largest battery energy storage system in Europe by megawatts per hour has begun its operation in Cottingham, UK. This system aims to store electricity generated from renewable sources, such as wind turbines and solar farms, before releasing it at times of high customer demand.
