What type of power supply is used in Taiwan?

In Taiwan, types A & B are the official standard. What is the mains voltage in Taiwan? The voltage in Taiwan is 110 volts and the frequency is 60 Hz. Dangerous situation: a type B plug is still connected to the mains, even when it's pulled halfway out!

What type of power outlet does Taipei use?

Taipei uses power outlets and plugs of types A & B. Take a look at the pictures below to see what these plugs and power sockets look like: Doesn't look familiar? Do the outlets look different in your country? You'll need a power plug adapter. Type A - Mostly used in the US, Canada, Mexico, Central America, China and Japan.

Do I need a power plug adapter for Taiwan?

Important note: If you're coming from a country that uses different plug types (like the UK, Europe, Australia, or many Asian countries), you'll need the appropriate adapter to use Taiwan's outlets. Before traveling to Taiwan, it's essential to check if your devices will work with the local Taiwan power plug system:

Do I need a travel adapter in Taipei?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Taipei are of types A & B (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you don't need a travel adapter. However, you may still need a voltage converter if the voltage is different.

Where can I buy a power adapter in Taiwan?

There are many different types of adapters available on Amazon that can be used in Taiwan. You can purchase a universal adapter that will fit most outlets in the world, or you can purchase a specific adapter for Taiwan. -> Find travel adapters on Amazon. Do I need a travel adapter or transformer when traveling to Taiwan?

Yes! North Americans do not need a travel adapter or transformer when traveling to Taiwan. Most device plugs will work with the outlet types in Taiwan. Also, the voltage in Taiwan is the same as in North America. Please note: an adapter will be needed if your device plug has a grounding pin and you are trying to use a Type A outlet.
